The Legacy 600's three separate cabin zones and enhanced interior ensure that you and your fellow travelers can work, rest, talk, play, dine — and even dream — in luxury.


At 1,650 cu. ft. (46.7 cu. m.), the jet's six-foot tall cabin offers a sense of space that is unsurpassed in the super midsize class. For entertainment in the air, there are two 17-in. standard flat screen monitors, DVD players with individual A/V controls and MP3 audio inputs in the cabin. And the plush, accommodating seats can be fully reclined for a restful flight.

After a good night's rest, you'll be refreshed and ready to work in the sun-washed cabin, where spacious comfort and thoughtfullydesigned features will help you be as productive in the air as you are on the ground.

Whether you're in a meeting at the conference table or working privately in a completely separate area, you'll stay connected with global coverage, including internet HSD (high speed data), Wi-Fi, a phone system with up to three lines for conferencing and power outlets for your laptops and other vital electronic devices.







#### FRESH HOSPITALITY.

The Legacy 600's newly designed, user-friendly galley serves as an elegant, welcoming entryway to the aircraft — and helps serve a wider variety of menus. We consulted with private aviation flight attendants in creating features for convenient storage and preparation of more food and beverages.

The sink, cylindrical in shape for stowing dishes, includes a lid that's also a cutting board; a practical container unit lets crew discreetly store and transport food. Three electrical outlets accommodate numerous kitchen devices, which can be configured to your needs. In addition to your choice of a microwave or convection oven, optional appliances include a refrigerator, a wine chiller, a larger or additional oven, or an oven/microwave combination.



# PRIVATE, PRODUCTIVE AND PEACEFUL.

The Legacy 600 provides a roomy, comfortable environment for 10 to 13 passengers. The three distinct privacy zones in the 1,650-cu.-ft. cabin mean that a lively discussion, a private meeting and a much-needed nap can all take place — without distraction — at the same time. Twenty-two large windows fill

the cabin with splendid sunlight in the daytime, increasing productivity, reducing jet-lag and making the large cabin feel even more spacious. A private aft lavatory offers ample room to change into fresh clothing from the adjacent baggage area, the largest in-flight accessible baggage compartment in this class.


















#### AN IRREPRESSIBLE PERFORMER.

The Legacy 600 combines global range with a takeoff distance of 5,551 ft., delivering a powerful performance for this category. On hot and high airfields or short runways, this jet is best-in-class. Once airborne, you can climb directly to 39,000 ft. and transition quickly to a comfortable altitude of 41,000 ft., where eight passengers can travel 3,250 nm.

So, where do you want to go? In the Legacy 600, you can fly directly from New York to London, from London to Dubai, Moscow to Addis Ababa or Singapore to Tokyo.



Observation: Takeoff and landing, sea level, ISA, without wind








## POWER AND CONTROL.

The Legacy 600 enjoys engineering that goes far beyond that of most executive jets — courtesy of Embraer's renowned heritage of aviation expertise. The jet is powered by two Rolls Royce AE3007 A1E high-bypass, turbofan, dual FADEC engines with built-in test equipment and trend monitoring. Fuel-efficient and ultra-quiet (external noise level is 13dB below the Stage IV requirements), they're rated at 7,987 lb. of static thrust at sea level, and have a flat rating of ISA +22°C, ensuring reliability in hot and high locations.

The FADEC-controlled Hamilton-Sundstrand APU interfaces with the CMC and operates up to FL390. It can be available during your entire mission, and is ideal for operation at airports with no support infrastructure. The heavy-duty, trailing-link landing gear requires only low maintenance, and has proven its reliability in high-utilization operations. Standard digital brake-by-wire system includes carbon fiber brakes and anti-skid protection with individual temperature alert.




We are committed to executive aviation, offering a full line of executive jets and expanding our executive jet customer service network to every region of the world.
